## Overview of Access to the Built Environment Courses – Institute of Access Training Australia

### Draft Disability (Access to Premises – Buildings) Standards Seminar – 2 hours - \$120 plus GST

The draft Access to Premises Standards were tabled in Parliament on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2008. Once consultation is finalised it is expected that these Standards will be introduced. They will mean significant change in the requirements for access for new and upgraded buildings in Australia.

This Seminar will provide an overview of the draft Access to Premises Standards, an update of their current status and a practical perspective of how they will be applied.
