



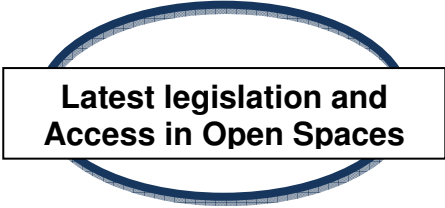

## Overview of Access to the Built Environment Courses – Institute of Access Training Australia

This course provides a framework for participants to understand and/or undertake an Access Appraisal of a building and covers the essential **key components** of access to buildings including:

- Overview of disability access issues
- Overview of relevant legislation and Australian Standards
- Identification of key access issues, barriers and solutions
- Use of an Access Appraisal Checklist
- Undertaking an Access Appraisal of a facility
- Reviewing and testing of knowledge learned

### Draft Disability (Access to Premises – Buildings) Standards Seminar – 2 hours - \$120 plus GST

The draft Access to Premises Standards were tabled in Parliament on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2008. Consultation is finalised and it is expected that these Standards will be introduced in line with the 2011 BCA. They will mean significant change in the requirements for access for new and upgraded buildings in Australia.

This Seminar will provide an overview of the draft Access to Premises Standards, an update of their current status and a practical perspective of how they will be applied.

### Addressing Access in Parks and Outdoor Spaces - 1 day \$650 plus GST
